### Situational Irony vs. Dramatic Irony (Week 5 Day 3)

1. Dramatic Irony: William had no idea that his parents had been told by his teacher that he was making a C. They knew he was lying when he said he had made a B. The reader is told that the parents were notified.
2. Situational Irony: In order to have her hairstyle, she blinded herself to the obstacles in her way. She ended up destroying her hairstyle.

### Identifying Irony (Week 5 Day 4)

1. Verbal: The waitress expresses gratitude when she intends the opposite
2. Dramatic: Reader's know that Lucy doesn't like Tom, but Tom believes the opposite
3. Situational: One might expect that Chef Kylie, a person who prepares dishes that are packed with meat would enjoy eating meat, when in fact the opposite is true
4. Verbal: Lawrence expresses the notion that the lemonade is priced fairly, when in fact the opposite is true
5. Situational: One might expect that the building inspect would have a safe home, when in fact the opposite was true
6. Dramatic: Tom believes he will continue working, but the reader knows that the opposite is true.
