

## **AGIREPAIR for MacBooks**

Isle of Wight County Schools has partnered with AGiREPAIR to provide an optional accidental coverage plan on student devices. The plan covers accidental damage, including liquid spills and \*cracked screens. It does not cover damage to the charger. \*Note it costs approximately \$269 for one cracked MacBook screen. The cost for the AGIREPAIR insurance for the MacBook laptops used by 7th & 8th graders is \$49 per device.

- The coverage plan is completely optional and provides coverage for one calendar year from September 24, 2022.
- Money must be received by your child's school by September 22, 2022.
- To purchase this AGiREPAIR insurance for your child's MacBook laptop, complete the form below and submit payment of cash or check written to GTMS in person to our bookkeeper, Mrs. Walker, in the GTMS office.
- You may also <u>return this completed form with a check written to GTMS with your child to their homeroom teacher</u> any day before the September 22 deadline.

## **Worth Avenue Group for MacBooks Information**

IWCS also continues to partner with Worth Avenue group which provides a full coverage option, including loss or theft of a device and power surge by lightning. The Worth Avenue group full coverage MacBook insurance costs \$116.00. The link to purchase insurance with Worth Avenue group is on the **GTMS website under Quick Links on the homepage**. Print copies of Worth Avenue group forms are available in the GTMS front office as well as in the GTMS library. This form below is to purchase the AGIREPAIR insurance, not the Worth Avenue group. **Enrollment in the Worth Avenue group insurance must be completed by parents independently with payment made directly to Worth Avenue group**.
